Description:

This workshop is aimed at researchers interested in the multimodal analysis of oral and sign languages using the programme ELAN. In order to analyse the linguistic interchange, it is necessary to be able to take into account the complete communicative context, including the visual component of language. Current technology allows us to store and recover multimedia files and ELAN will allow us to include the oral and visual elements captured in the holistic linguistic interaction. In this workshop we will learn how to use ELAN to analyse and annotate not only gestures used in oral languages but also manual and non manual signs employed in signed languages. The workshop will be divided into three parts: the first day, a theoretical background showing the importance of the visual component in language will be presented. The second day, a hands on approach to using ELAN will be carried out. The third day, the participants will be divided into two groups according to their interest in either sign language or oral language.
