Additional Remarks	<p>Due to its nature, this course does not have any syllabus. Each student develops 175-240 hours of internships in a Company I and 175-240 hours in Company II, with competences in different aspects of environmental character, thus adjusting its activity to that of the company. The variety of companies in which students complete these practices is such that it is necessary to follow up on each student. Therefore the course includes a part of academic tutoring, which will be developed through group sessions and individualized sessions, in which the academic tutor counsels the students.</p>
